3) Area Incidents / After Incident Reviews

4) Outreach

Eclipse related meetings were discussed as well as building on those meetings to create new TIMs groups (Rural Penobscot, Washington, Aroostook County).

5) Technology

BACTS Staff discussed the contracts that DOT has out to purchase more TIMs technology.

6) Construction Season
