2) Area Incidents / After Incident Reviews

A fatal accident occurred on East Millinocket Road, resulting in the road being shut down for several hours. Emergency response teams acted promptly and efficiently, and all traffic-related procedures were handled effectively

The incident on Lake Road was managed with support from East Millinocket, with Baxter personnel covering one end of the scene and the Millinocket Fire Department handling the other

3) Outreach

It is proposed that we reach out to law enforcement and fire departments in Lincoln and Howland, Maine, to explore opportunities for TIMS training and shared experience.

4) Technology

Message boards were deployed throughout the area. Additionally, new personal safety lights, warning signs, guardian angel and electronic road flares are now available through the TIMS program.

5) Construction Season

Bridge construction is currently underway in Medway; however, there has been a lack of communication regarding construction activities and events in the surrounding area making it hard to coordinate traffic efforts.

157 in Medway, heading uphill, a sign has been placed in a location that creates confusion and does not effectively communicate the road closure in the area where it is most relevant.

A lack of coordination with DOT construction may result in challenges to effectively redirecting/changing traffic during an emergency situation
