2) Area Incidents / After Incident Reviews

- The group discussed the MM23 potato carrying semi-truck accident after-action review
- MM13 fuel-truck collision with deer, 2-3 lane closure for 1-2 hours. Local paving trucks assisted with lane closures and buffers. Lanes were slowly opened and returned to normal as the accident cleared.
- The group discussed summer traffic slow-downs, specifically holiday traffic on the Maine Turnpike.
