**2) Area Incidents / After Incident Reviews**

Pedestrian crash around 5pm near Bangor Savings on Central St in Millinocket, road was closed for around 4-hours with assistance from Millinocket FD, East-Millinocket PD, and Sheriff's Department. Detours caused some delays for tractor trailers.

Newburgh experienced a fatality on Route 69 with a car and tractor trailer. Penobscot County Sheriff, State Police, Carmel FD, and Newburgh FD were on scene for a total of 9-hours. The group discussed roadway safety implications of the Newburgh Route 69 and 202 intersection.

Milford FD discussed the difficulty of crashes on Main Rd near Bradley due to lack of available detour routes. Milford FD is trying to get railroad crossing gates installed due to previous crashes on the train tracks.

The group discussed preparation for the Millinocket Marathon.

**3) Outreach**

BACTS Staff discussed their outreach with a TIM booth at the Maine Municipal conference. BACTS also shared the upcoming plans for Crash Responder Safety Week.
