2) Presentation - Nick King from NH DOT

- Nick provided a presentation about increased response times to suicide incidents on the I-95 Piscataqua River bridge
- Object analytic cameras are now able to identify pedestrians and stopped vehicles to trigger detection at the TMC to notify responders of a potential suicide attempt
